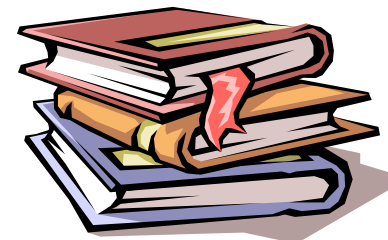
Future visits

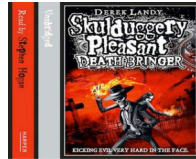
